### 2025 J/80 East Coast Championships

Thank you for joining us at the 37th Annual J-Jamboree and the 2025 J/80 East Coast Championships! Read on for helpful information about arrival, launch and haul, meals and joining us at the Winnepesaukee Yacht Club.

#### Arrival and launch:

---

- The check-in and launch window is Thursday afternoon and Friday morning as noted in the Notice of Race.
- Launching and mast-up services will occur at Fays Boat Yard at 71 Varney Point Road, Gilford, NH 03249.
- Check-in will be at the Winnepesaukee Yacht Club at 45 Dockham Shore Road, Gilford, NH 03249.
- Please jointly email [Tavis@faysboatyard.com](mailto:Tavis@faysboatyard.com) and [Cat@lwsa.org](mailto:Cat@lwsa.org) in advance with your approximate arrival time. No need to check in before going to the hoist.
- Sailboats will be assigned a mooring at the Winnepesaukee Yacht Club. After launching, motor from Smith Cove to the WYC dock to receive your mooring assignment.
- Trailers will be stored at 4 Varney Point Road.

#### Meals:

---

- Meals will be provided Friday and Saturday at the WYC and are included in the registration fee.
- Guest tickets are available for meals Friday and Saturday evenings at a rate of \$25 per person per meal. Email [cat@lwsa.org](mailto:cat@lwsa.org) with the number of guests for each

meal. Please be prepared to pay at regatta check in with cash or a check made out to the LWSA.

- Friday evening's meal at WYC will be brisket and pulled pork with cornbread and baked beans. Saturday evening's meal will be grilled chicken with sausage, salad and pasta.
  - For those not eating meat, veggie burgers will be available both nights.

- Muffins and coffee will be available Saturday and Sunday mornings at the WYC.
- The WYC is not a staffed facility. While meals and some drinks will be provided, you are welcome to bring and enjoy your own beverages and snacks on site.

- The WYC includes ample parking, and parking on the grass is permitted. Please do not block the boat ramp.
- A chart will be provided in your welcome bag. With this summer's drought the lake level is at historic lows. The racing area is largely clear, but there are marks to mind on the commute out. Please study the chart attached on the next page and in your welcome bag, be aware of the marks and, when in doubt, follow a local and don't go too close to shore.
