

2026 ONBOARD TRAINING CERTIFICATE

On-board training: The captain and not less than 80% of the boat's racing crew shall, prior to the start of the race, participate in on-board training, including annual man-overboard procedures, use of the life raft, lifejackets, safety harnesses, main boom preventer, communications equipment, pyrotechnics, EPIRB(s), fire prevention, firefighting and the procedures for abandoning ship, dismasting and rudder/steering loss or failure. **All participating crew shall sign and date the On Board Training Certificate.**



Emergency steering:

A boat shall have an emergency tiller, capable of being fitted to the rudder stock.

Wheel steered boats shall have an emergency tiller, capable of being fitted to the rudder stock.

Annual Man Overboard Drill:

Annual man overboard procedures shall be appropriate for the boat's size and speed and practiced by no less than 2/3 of the race crew. The practice shall consist of marking and returning to a position on the water, and demonstrating a method of hoisting a crew member back on deck, or other consistent means of re-boarding the crew member.
