1. All boats participating in Class racing shall have bottom paint on all wetted surfaces of the hull.
SAT _____ UNSAT _____
2. Masts shall have two bands. Each band shall be 3/4" wide, minimum, and shall contrast in color with the mast. The top of the lower band shall be 42" above the deck, not the raised molded area where the mast is stepped. The bottom of the upper mast band shall be 25' above the top of the lower mast band.

3. Booms shall have one band. The band shall be 3/4" wide, minimum, and shall contrast in color to the boom. With the boom located in place on the mast, the forward edge of the band shall be located 11' from the aft side of the mast, not the main track.

4. The spinnaker pole shall be circular in cross section and shall conform to the following specification: - Outside Diameter: 1 7/8" Minimum - Material: Extruded Aluminum - Length: 10' Maximum

5. The Helmsman for the Cal 25 National Championship Regatta shall fall into one of the two categories outlined below:
 - Current or past titled owner of a Cal 25.
 - Immediate family member of a currently titled owner of a Cal 25. Immediate Family members are only eligible to helm his/her family's Cal 25.

6. All boats shall be equipped with bow pulpits.
SAT _____ UNSAT _____
7. All boats shall carry an outboard motor that has a minimum horsepower rating of 5 HP.
SAT _____ UNSAT _____
8. Bunk pads of 3" minimum thickness and covering all forepeak and cabin bunk locations will be carried in their normal position during all one-design racing.
SAT _____ UNSAT _____
9. All boats shall carry a minimum of one and a maximum of two marine or automotive style batteries at all times.
SAT _____ UNSAT _____
10. Boats shall carry on board at all times the U.S. Coast Guard defined minimum equipment for recreational vessels. Please refer to the USCG web site for a list of this equipment. In addition, all boats shall carry the following items:

a. Operable head or Porta-Potty	b. Fog or signaling Horn	c. Compass
