& TRAILER ASSIGNMENT LOCATIONS

J/24 Arrival

NEW SINCE 2024 – The new SSA gate can only be opened with a keyfob, so a volunteer or staff member has to swipe you in when you arrive. The gate will open for only one vehicle at a time and then closes quickly, so do not sit under the gate.

Upon arrival to SSA Thursday, check in with the lot volunteer at the gate, who will guide you to your designated trailer spot. Your bow number is your spot number. Spots are marked (with yellow parking lot tape) on the ground with your bow number and the number is the center of the spot. Make sure you leave adequate room for boats to park next to you. Your trailer hitch needs to be behind the yellow lines.

If you plan to arrive on Tues or Wed, please coordinate your arrival time with Mike Coe or Kelly FitzGerald as you will need to be swiped in.

All boats/trailers **must** be parked in their assigned spot for the duration of the event. **Note: Trucks will only be permitted in the lot upon boat arrival and upon boat departure**. Once your boat is parked in its designated spot, and you have unloaded your equipment, trucks must be removed from the property. Boats will be moved on the lot via tractor/dollies only, including for launching and haul out.

On Sunday, trucks will be permitted back on the property when you are hooking up to depart. A Volunteer will swipe you back in the gate when you are ready to leave.

Please do not block the dumpster on Thursday until the dumpster is picked up/cones removed.

Berthing

Boats will be rafting up in all three basins. **Bring your fenders and some extra, long dock lines!** Basin 1 is a floating dock, and Basins 2 and 3 are fixed piers.

Be aware there is a junior regatta this weekend and the Junior Club staff will be launching/returning 420s to their floating docks in the mornings and afternoons. Please do not berth against the 420 floating docks. We will remind you of this at the Skipper's Meeting.

Haul-out

Boats will haul out at all three hoists and then return to their assigned trailer parking spot to drop rigs. There will be a volunteer at each hoist to assist and manage the haul out process. One crew member for each boat will be requested to retrieve their trailer when they are next-up in line. Do not get your trailer until you have been asked to do so by a lot volunteer.
