NOTICE OF RACE

The notation '[NP]' in a rule in the SIs means that instruction is not grounds for protest or a request for redress by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1 and 61.1(a).

1 RULES

- 1.1 Crescent Sail Yacht Club is the Organizing Authority (OA) for the 2026 Crescent One Design Regatta.
- 1.2 The Crescent One Design Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.3 In accordance with the US Sailing prescription to RRS 88.2, Appendix R, the prescriptions to the preamble to Part 5 and prescriptions to RRS 65.1, 70.3(b), and 76.1 will always apply. No other US Sailing prescriptions will apply.
- 1.4 Rule 60.4(a)(2) is changed as follows: "(2) if it alleges a breach of a rule of Part 2 or rule 31 and is from a boat that was not involved in, and did not see, the incident, or"
- 1.5 The Sailing Instructions may change other racing rules.

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 The OA may require that sponsor or other regatta stickers be attached to each starting boat.
- 2.2 Advertising is permitted in accordance with World Sailing Regulation 20, Advertising Code.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The Crescent One Design Regatta is open to one design fleets between 13' and 30.33' LOA.
- 3.2 Classes not referenced within the Yacht Scoring registration form may be added with OA approval.
- 3.3 A minimum of five (5) registered boats is required for a class start unless otherwise approved by the OA.

- 3.4 The total number of classes will be at the discretion of the OA. Classes may be limited due to course limitations. Class acceptance and approval will be given to classes with at least the minimum number of paid entries prior to midnight of Sunday, May 17th, 2026.
- 3.5 Eligible boats must enter online at the event website www.yachtscoring.com.
- 3.6 Eligible boats shall meet all entry requirements, including completion of the online entry information and payment of the entry fee no later than June 12, 2025.

4 ENTRY FEE

4.1 The entry fee shall be \$125 and includes:

- All Racing
- Rigging Party – Friday, June 12th
- Awards
- Awards Lunch – Sunday June 14th

Dinner on Saturday, June 13th is NOT included in the registration fee. Tickets can be purchased online or on the event site.

4.2 An early registration fee of \$100 is available to all boats registering prior to midnight Sunday, May 17th.

5 SCHEDULE

5.1 Crew lists and signed waiver forms must be submitted at registration. No boat will be registered without a completed waiver form.

5.2 Schedule of Races:

- Saturday, June 13th, 2026
- Sunday, June 14th, 2026

5.3 Skippers Meeting: Saturday, June 13th, 2026 at 09:00 hrs. in the CSYC Launch area.

5.4 Saturday, June 13th harbor signal is scheduled for 10:00 hrs. The first warning signal is scheduled for 11:00 hrs. Sunday, June 14th harbor signal is scheduled for 09:00 hrs. The first warning signal is scheduled for 10:00 hrs.

5.5 No warning signal will be made after 14:00 hrs. on Sunday, June 14th. There is no maximum number of races.

5.6 No more than 5 races per day

Friday June 12th

- Arrival & Rigging with Refreshments 12:00 hrs.
- Campfire & Acoustic Entertainment 19:00 hrs.

Saturday June 13th

- Breakfast Bar 08:00 hrs.
- Racing 11:00 – approx. 16:00 hrs.
- Dinner & Entertainment 18:00 – 22:00 hrs.

Sunday June 14th

- Breakfast Bar 07:30 hrs.
- Racing 10:00 – approx. 14:00 hrs.
- Awards and BBQ 15:30 hrs.

6 MEASUREMENT & WEIGH-IN

Measurement and weigh-in are not required by the OA.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available at registration and online at the event website.

8 VENUE AND COURSES

- 8.1 Racing areas (2-3 circles) will be located off Crescent Sail Yacht Club on the waters of Lake St. Clair.
- 8.2 The courses for all classes will be windward-leeward and may include an offset mark near the windward mark as well as leeward gates. The length and number of legs will be at the discretion of the Race Committee.
- 8.3 The Race Committee will use flags for starting classes.

9 ARBITRATION AND APPEALS

- 9.1 Appendix V shall apply.
- 9.2 The chairperson of the jury at his discretion may assign protests, requests for redress and reports received under RRS 69.2(a) to the protest committee. As provided in RRS 70.5, there will be no appeal from the decisions of the jury.

10 SCORING

In accordance with RRS A2.1, each boat's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races. Three (3) races shall constitute a series.

11 MOORING

Mooring is included with registration at areas designated by Crescent Sail Yacht Club beginning Thursday June 11th. (Thursday). Alternative arrangements can be made by contacting the OA in advance.

12 HAUL OUT RESTRICTIONS

Boats may be wet or dry sailed during the event as class rules allow.

13 RADIO COMMUNICATION

[NP]The Race Committee may provide general information to competitors on a designated courtesy VHF radio channel. Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats.

14 PRIZES

Series prizes will be awarded for 1st through 3rd places for all classes.

15 RISK STATEMENT

RRS 3 states: "The Responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone." By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. **Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia, or other causes.**

16 AMENDMENTS TO NOR

Amendments to this NOR will be posted on the event website, and after May 17th, 2026, on Yacht Scoring.

17 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall hold adequate insurance including third party liability insurance.

18 HOUSING

18.1 Camping may be allowed with advance approval from OA.

18.2 A limited number of housing hosts may be available on a first come first serve basis for sailors. For more information, please contact OA.
